

To the campus community:

Work continues on the McIver Building occupant relocation plan in anticipation of the construction of the new Nursing and Instructional Building. As promised, we are providing this update to keep you informed of our progress.

Judy Smith, director of space management, and Jorge Quintal, associate vice chancellor for facilities, along with department representatives, have identified space for all departments moving out of McIver. A complete list of the units currently occupying McIver and the proposed location for each unit are available online at <https://facdc.uncg.edu/nursing/>, under “Department Relocation.” As part of the relocation plan, the university will be renovating property at 840 Neal Street (the former Salvation Army building) and properties located at 326 and 328 South Tate Street and 812 Lilly Avenue. We wish to express our appreciation to the staff of the units currently occupying McIver for their collaboration and creativity. Finding workable solutions to relocating these units is a significant challenge. The consideration and cooperation of all those involved played a critical role in identifying viable solutions for each unit that is being moved.

UNCG Facilities Design and Construction staff and the department representatives on the Design Oversight Committee are working to refine the program requirements for the new Nursing and Instructional Building occupants. The programming effort will be completed in November and the design work will start promptly in December 2016.
